You can view the manuals for this software in the following manner.

1. There are four methods that you can use to start the software.
 - Double-click the shortcut icon **DL950/SL2000 File Utility** on the desktop.
 - Click **Windows** (Start) > **YOKOGAWA** > **DL950/SL2000 File Utility**.
2. Select **Manual** from the **Help** menu. The manual for this software will open.

To view the PDF data, you need Adobe Acrobat Reader or a software application that can open PDF data.


Installing the DL950/SL2000 File Utility

OSs that the DL950/SL2000 File Utility supports: Microsoft Windows 10, or Windows 11.


1. Start Windows. Log on to Windows using a user account with administrative privilege.
2. Double-click **setup.exe** in the extracted folder.
3. The following dialog box opens. Select the language (English (United States) or Japanese) and click **OK**.




4. If a Requirements window appears, review the requirements and click **Install**.
5. DL950/SL2000 File Utility InstallShield Wizard dialog box appears. Click **Next**.




6. The following dialog box appears containing license agreement information. Confirm the license agreement, click the I accept the terms in the license agreement option button, and click **Next**.




7. A dialog box for entering user information appears. Click **Next**.




8. A dialog box for selecting the setup type appears. Click **Next**.
