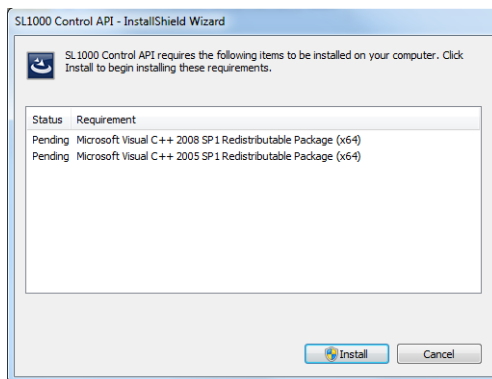
Installing the SL1000 Control AP

OSs that the SL1000 Control API supports: Microsoft Windows 7, Windows 8, and Windows 8.1.

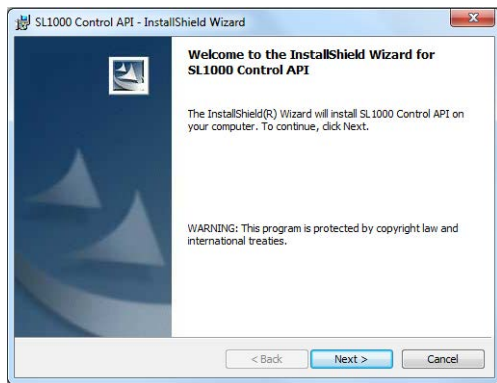
1. Start Windows. Log on to Windows using a user account with administrative privilege.
2. Insert the SL1000 Control API Setup Disk into your PC's CD-ROM drive.
3. Start [setup.exe] in the CD-ROM.
4. The following dialog box opens. Select the language (English (United States) or Japanese) and click OK..



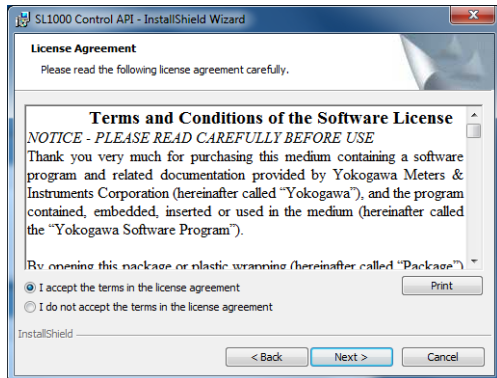
5. The install dialog box for Microsoft Visual C++2008 SP1 opens. Click Install.



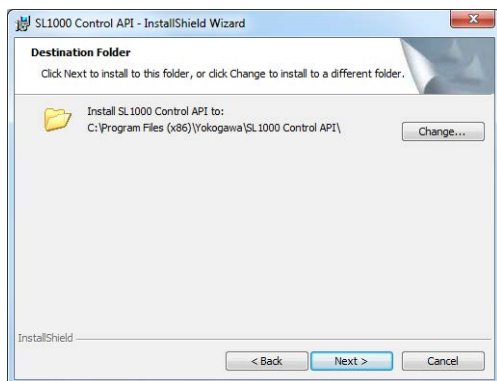

6. When the installation of Microsoft Visual C++2008 SP1 is completed, SL1000 Control API InstallShield Wizard dialog box appears.
Click Next.



7. The following dialog box appears containing license agreement information. Confirm the license agreement, click the I accept the terms in the license agreement option button, and click Next.



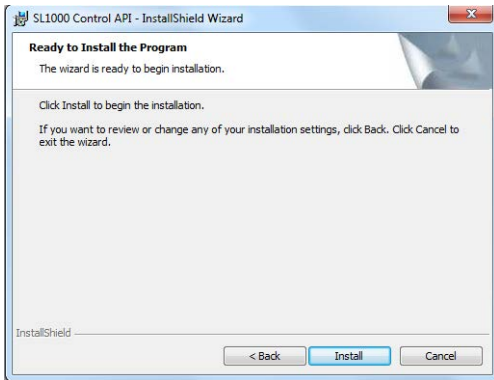
8. Specify the installation destination. The default installation destination is set to "\Program Files (X86)\YOKOGAWA\SL1000 Control API". If this is OK, click Next. To change the installation directory, click Change, select the directory, and click Next.



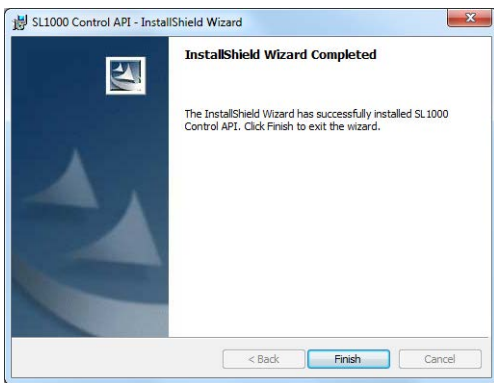
Note
